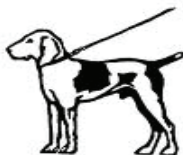
*Rules & Regulations*

1. NO dogs in season will be allowed to compete in any event.
2. Any dog that shows aggression towards a person or another dog will be dismissed and asked to leave the fair grounds.
3. Dogs MUST be on a leash and be under control at all times. The exception is when the dog is being shown in the ring in a performance event. The leash must be placed back on the dog before the dog leaves the ring.
4. NO dogs in whelp will be allowed to compete the day of the event.
5. **All dogs must be current on their vaccinations and must be prepared to present documentation if asked.**
6. Show officials are not responsible for any accidents.
7. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs, if not; it can result in penalties assessed in the events in which the exhibitor is competing or dismissal of entry.
8. Each exhibitor will compete in their respective age division and/or class and at no time will the exhibitor be competing against another age division and/or class.
9. The exhibitor can move up a class but at no time can they move down a class.
10. Dogs must be in crates or with the handler on leash. At no time should the dog be tied up or kept in an enclosed vehicle with windows rolled all the way up.
11. The exhibitor is responsible for bringing all their own equipment: leashes, crate, collars, etc.
12. Rally signs, jumps and in case of agility, agility equipment will be provided.
13. Dogs are not allowed to enter any other part of the fair grounds except the building where show is being held. All dogs must leave the fair grounds as soon as the show is over.
14. Each event will be \$5.00 entry fee.
