

## 2010 Crawford County Queen Pageant Official Rules & Regulations

1. A contestant must be a resident of Crawford County at least one year prior to pageant.
2. A contestant must be 16 years of age by Sept. 1st.
3. Former County Fair Queens are not eligible to participate.
4. Contestant must be a single female, never have been married or had a marriage annulled, contestant can never have been or be pregnant.
5. Contestant must be a US Citizen and never have been convicted of a felony offense.
6. Contestant agrees to be personally interviewed by the judges, appear in business, church or professional attire for judging.
7. If chosen Miss Crawford County, winner agrees to represent Crawford County and compete for the title of Miss Arkansas State Fair 2010. Contest will be held in Little Rock, AR. Information will be provided to Queen by pageant director. The Queen must be accompanied by a chaperone at all times during the event of the fair and at any personal appearances when she is wearing her crown. (When making personal appearances, no jeans or slacks are permitted.) This chaperone should be preferable a parent, or adult family member over the age of 21.
8. If for any reason, your permanent residence should change to outside Crawford County within your reign, privileges connected with the said title shall also be handed down to the first runner up.
9. In case of marriage, pregnancy, living with a man, or any reason the Queen is unable to fulfill her obligations as the reigning Queen, or any reason which the pageant director deems unacceptable of a Queen, the queen will relinquish the title of Miss Crawford County IMMEDIATELY, and all privileges connected with the said title, together with ALL prizes awarded to her, and a runner-up shall be awarded all prizes as if she were chosen queen on pageant night - her crown, sash, scholarship, and every gift not inscribed with her name. She shall be succeeded by the next eligible contestant.
10. Entrant agrees to abide by all the rules of the County and State contests now in effect or as hereafter announced.
11. Interview session will be held at the fairground commercial building at 4:00pm the day of the pageant.
12. Swimsuit must be brought to rehearsal to be approved by pageant director. String bikini's and thongs are not allowed.
13. Entrant must participate in parade on Saturday morning of the pageant in downtown Mulberry.
14. Illegal drugs, alcohol & smoking will definitely not be tolerated. If you have been arrested or charged with drugs or alcohol, or been treated for either, you will not be eligible to participate.
15. The Queen will be expected to represent Crawford County to gain as much exposure as possible - visit schools, local civic groups, open houses, parades, special speaking engagements, etc.
16. Photo will be taken the day of the registration meeting for the newspaper and for the photogenic contest.
17. Rehearsal schedule will be given out at meeting.
18. Audience appeal award - Each contestant will have a container to collect votes for audience favorite. Each vote will be \$1. Funds collected are used for repairs to building, decorations, and pageant needs.

Scholarships will be awarded as follows :

Winner - \$1000 to the U of A, Fort Smith or \$500 to choice of college

1st runner up - \$250 to college of choice

2nd runner up - \$150 to college of choice
